OVERVIEW

This workshop will share the system the CSS Workgroup has updated to address the following areas: Every-growing caseloads; individualized determination of therapy services; concerns with students missing classroom instruction; consistent identification of students who have a significant speech/language disability; English Language Learners; and *NOW INCLUDING* additional data on Pragmatics and Complex Communication needs.

At the conclusion of a half-day CSS training, participants will be skilled in applying the CSS to analyze students on their caseloads and make recommendations for speech and language services to IEP teams. The training is comprised of six components:

1. Overview of the CSS process and legal requirements
2. Referral strategies
3. Review of the articulation, voice, fluency, language, and complex communication needs scales
4. Service Guidelines based on the CSS ratings
5. Large group positive practice utilizing case studies to apply the CSS Scales
6. Small group independent practice

Course meets the qualification for 4 hours of continuing professional development credit for Speech Language Pathologist as required by the California Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensers Board.
